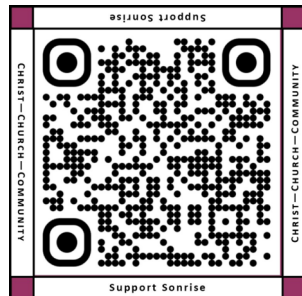

What to watch for this week.
