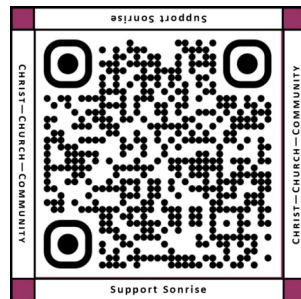

Jesus in Isaiah

- ◆ Isaiah 52.13 NASB Behold, My servant will prosper, He will be high and lifted up and greatly exalted.
- ◆ The book has five servant songs that **detail** the _____ (life), _____ (sacrifice), and _____ (kingdom) of Jesus.
- ◆ **MINISTRY:** Jesus has a tough life filled with turmoil and conflict. * He is extremely _____, unimpressive; there is nothing to draw you to him or see that he will do great things.
- ◆ **MISSION:** Isaiah's _____, Jesus, is the substantial atonement sacrifice of Leviticus 16. He is **the guilt offering** for our sins. This is detailed in his betrayal, trial, suffering, death, and burial. Isaiah's description of this is brutal.
- ◆ **MAJESTY:** Here is the eternal kingdom and its king, Jesus. He is exalted to the right hand of God. Placed in the position of administering judgment upon each person as the cross through death's door.
- ◆ "For the _____ is our judge, the _____ is our lawgiver, the _____ is our king; it is _____ who will _____ us." – Isaiah 33:22
- ◆ "In _____ a throne will be established; in _____ a man will sit on it— one from the house of David— one who in judging seeks justice and speeds the cause of righteousness." – Isaiah 16:5
- ◆ "You will keep in _____ those whose minds are steadfast because they trust in you." – Isaiah 26:3

- ◆ The church will expand beyond any barriers. The Church is open to all nations and nationalities. Isaiah told them to “Enlarge the place of your tent.” They are to prepare for growth.
