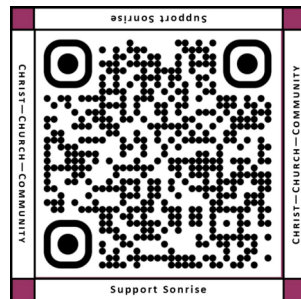

This week, let's look at Conditional Promises

In the Word of God, **CONDITIONAL PROMISES** require the individual to fulfill set conditions before God responds. Each day, consider what God wants, why, and the results of obedience and the outcome of not following through. These are not paired, so each day you will be doing two separate studies.

MONDAY—Read Deuteronomy 28.1-4 & James 4.8

TUESDAY—Read Psalm 1.11-3 & Matthew 6.33

WEDNESDAY—Read John 15.7-8 & Psalms 37.4

THURSDAY—Read Proverbs 3.5-6 & 1 John 1.9

FRIDAY—2 Chronicles 7.14 & Luke 9.23

BONUS - James 4.7-8 & 1 Timothy 5.8

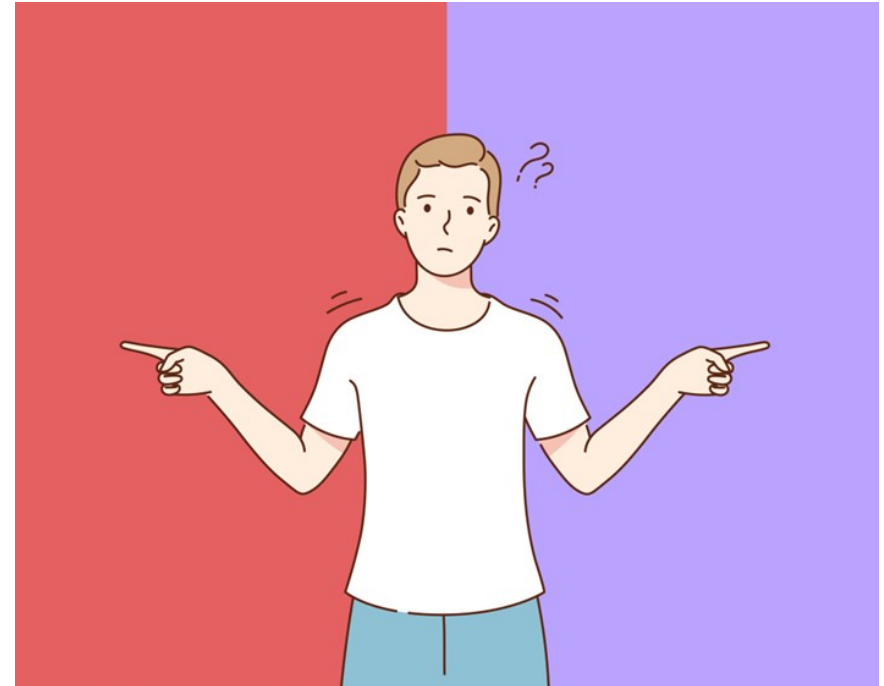
